Without Walls (w.e.f April 2024)	Without Walls' was a unique educational program for Class 5 that <b>fostered lifelong learning</b> , <b>curiosity</b> , <b>and exploration</b> . Through interactive audio-visual aids and associative learning, students developed a broad knowledge base, critical thinking, and effective communication skills.
Karadi Path (w.e.f April 2025)	The Karadi Path, an English language enrichment program, follows an intuitive, immersive approach to language learning, similar to how children acquire their mother tongue. It integrates music, actions, reading, and storytelling to enhance pronunciation, fluency, and vocabulary without direct grammar instruction. By implementing this program for Classes 1 and 2, the school aims to provide an engaging learning experience that builds confidence and creativity.

## **Academic Result and Awards:**

- The school has been consistently garnering commendable results, achieving 100% pass percentage.
- Through the academic session, students were observed and assessed on a range of scholastic and co-scholastic parameters for which they were acknowledged and awarded through Achiever's and Scholar's Badges and Certificates of Appreciation.

## **School Events**

### **Technovation 2024**
