Bhavan Vidyalaya, New Chandigarh, represents an extension of Bhavan Vidyalaya Chandigarh and proudly holds its position as the third campus within the distinguished purview of Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, Chandigarh Kendra. Recognized for its unwavering commitment to providing exceptional education and cultivating a comprehensive approach to student development, this institution is wholeheartedly dedicated to nurturing and honing the inherent potential of its student body. In the pursuit of fostering versatility and holistic growth, students are exposed to a wide spectrum of activities and opportunities, empowering them to freely express their creative talents within their chosen domains.

Earning recognition on the academic landscape of Bhavan's northern and north-eastern regions, the school has left an indelible mark as a trailblazer. In the academic year 2022-23, Bhavan Vidyalaya, New Chandigarh embarked on its journey with the same enthusiasm and unwavering dedication that characterizes its parent organization, ensuring a continuation of the exceptional educational standards that align with the CBSE norms.

SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE

Building and Classrooms:

The Vidyalaya boasts an impressive building, with some parts already functional and others under construction. The school features a sufficient number of classrooms, a library, and activity rooms. All classrooms are spacious, airy, well-lit, well-ventilated, and equipped with smart, interactive boards with internet facilities in most of the classes.

Library:

The school library, housed in a spacious and well-organized room, continues to be a vibrant hub of knowledge and learning. It boasts a rich collection of 5,460 books, including 2,900 purchased titles, 2,560 generous donations, and 194 textbooks. The collection is thoughtfully categorized into 132 reference books, 3,198 storybooks, 1,216 general books, and 720 fiction titles, catering to diverse interests and reading levels.

To keep students informed and engaged, the library subscribes to six daily newspapers and ten periodicals. It is further enhanced with digital resources, educational magazines, maps, and globes, offering a comprehensive learning experience.

Throughout the year, the library has actively promoted reading culture by organizing a range of literary activities such as DEAR (Drop Everything and Read) sessions, bookmark-making workshops, book reviews, author studies, and book talks across all grade levels. These initiatives have significantly enriched students' literary appreciation and fostered a love for reading.

Computer Labs:

The school has two well-equipped computer labs, each with an adequate number of computers and state-of-the-art smart interactive boards. High-speed internet connectivity ensures that students have the resources they need for research and online assignments.

State-of-the-Art Laboratories

In alignment with the latest CBSE norms and to enhance experiential learning, the school has recently upgraded its Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and Psychology laboratories with modern equipment and improved infrastructure. These state-of-the-art labs now provide students with

hands-on learning opportunities that complement their theoretical understanding and foster scientific inquiry.

- a) **The Physics Lab** is equipped with advanced apparatus and experimental setups that enable students to explore core concepts such as electricity, magnetism, optics, and mechanics. The lab environment promotes critical thinking and accurate observation, helping learners strengthen their analytical skills.
- b) **The Chemistry Lab** is designed with a strong emphasis on safety and functionality. It features updated workstations, lab-grade chemicals, and modern glassware to conduct experiments related to chemical reactions, acid-base titration, salts, and organic chemistry. The lab ensures a safe and stimulating environment for inquiry-based learning.
- c) **The Biology Lab** houses upgraded microscopes, preserved specimens, anatomical models, and slide preparation tools. It encourages students to explore the intricacies of life sciences through dissections, cell studies, and other hands-on biological experiments, fostering curiosity and scientific temper.
- d) The newly enhanced **Psychology Lab** supports the practical component of senior secondary psychology. It is well-equipped with psychological testing tools, assessment scales, and materials for conducting experiments in areas such as learning, memory, personality, and intelligence. The lab provides an ideal environment for students to gain practical insights into human behaviour and mental processes.
- e) The school's **comprehensive science laboratory** is equipped with charts, reagents, slides, microscopes, experimental apparatus, and specimen models. These facilities are instrumental in fostering practical, hands-on scientific inquiry. The lab activities are integrated with the curriculum so as to give experiential learning to students of all levels on the school.
- f) **The Maths Lab** is equipped with Junior and Senior Mathematics Kits, which include tools like shapes, dice, abacus, mathematical charts, fraction and circle kits, mensuration kits, and probability kits. The school curriculum integrates Math lab activities at all levels to give students a hands-on experience of playing and learning mathematical concepts.
- g) Equipped with cutting-edge technology in collaboration with NAAR, our newly established **AI and Robotics Lab** aims to provide students with hands-on experience in artificial intelligence and robotics, fostering innovation and technological literacy. These experiences turn theoretical knowledge into practical solutions, sharpening technical skills and encouraging critical thinking, thereby preparing students to excel in a rapidly evolving technological landscape.

Together, these laboratories serve as dynamic learning spaces where students are encouraged to observe, experiment, and innovate—developing both scientific aptitude and a deep appreciation for the subjects.

Well-Equipped Grounds and Sports Facilities:

The school takes pride in its expansive and well-maintained grounds that support a wide array of sports and physical education activities. These open spaces not only promote physical fitness but also encourage teamwork, discipline, and sportsmanship among students.

Our outdoor sports infrastructure includes a full-sized football field, a basketball court, and a badminton court, offering students ample opportunities to engage in structured sports training and inter-house competitions. A dedicated skating area and a specially designed play zone for pre-primary students further enhance the inclusivity of physical activities across all age groups.

In addition to outdoor amenities, the school has a well-equipped indoor sports room that facilitates games like carom, table tennis, and gymnastics, ensuring year-round sporting engagement irrespective of weather conditions.

Looking ahead, we are excited to share that a swimming pool is currently under development and is expected to be ready by the next academic session. This upcoming addition will further enrich our sports infrastructure and provide students with access to aquatic sports and swimming training.

Through this well-rounded sports environment, the school remains committed to nurturing the physical and mental well-being of every student.

New Assembly Area:

Recently constructed, our new assembly area provides a spacious and conducive environment for school gatherings and events, enhancing the overall experience for students and staff alike.

Music & Dance Rooms:

The school provides dedicated spaces for music and dance. The music room is well-equipped with a variety of musical instruments, while the dance room offers a versatile space for dance practices and creative movement.

Art Room:

The Art Room is equipped with various art supplies, from paints to sketchbooks, providing a canvas for students' imagination and self-expression.

Counsellor's Room:

The counsellor's room provides a private and supportive environment for students to discuss any issues they may be facing, with a trained counsellor available for both personal and group counselling.

Pre-Primary Activity Room:

The activity room for the youngest learners is adorned with various educational toys and soft, cuddly companions, ensuring a joyful and engaging atmosphere for learning through play.

Examination Cum Academic Room:

This secure space is designated for the storage of examination and academic records, maintaining confidentiality and providing an optimal location for precise table marking.

Medical Room:

The school features a spacious, well-equipped medical facility staffed by a qualified nurse, with regular health check-ups conducted by qualified doctors. Special sessions are held by trained medical personnel for both staff and students.

School Buses:

The school provides transportation with a fleet of twelve buses, each equipped with a robust GPS tracking system, trained drivers, and lady attendants, ensuring student safety during travel in alignment with CBSE norms.

Security Measures: CCTV Surveillance:

CCTV cameras are installed throughout the school campus for the safety and security of students. The Principal and Vice Principal have access to the security system.

Multi-Purpose Seminar Room:

The school's well-equipped Seminar Room serves as a dynamic space for hosting a variety of workshops, training sessions, and interactive sessions for both students and teachers. Designed to foster collaborative learning and professional development, the room is outfitted with high-speed internet connectivity and a multimedia projector, supporting effective presentations and digital learning experiences. Throughout the year, it has been actively utilized for subject enrichment workshops, orientation programmes, guest lectures, and capacity-building sessions.

STUDENT STRENGTH

The Vidyalaya has enrolled a total of 993 students, comprising 550 male and 443 female students (as on 24.03.2025).

SCHOOL SCHEDULE

The institution follows a six-day-a-week schedule, with each school day extending over a duration of 6 hours and 10 minutes.

The school is affiliated with the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi, for the Secondary Examination, underscoring our commitment to providing education of the highest calibre.

Dedicated and Innovative Teaching Staff

The teaching faculty comprises 51 qualified members, including the Principal, who work collaboratively to create engaging and learner-centric classroom experiences. Supporting the foundation years, 14 teacher assistants are actively involved in the Pre-Primary wing, ensuring personalized attention and a nurturing environment for young learners. The collective efforts of the staff reflect the school's commitment to academic excellence and holistic development.

Administrative Staff

The administrative staff ensures financial transparency through regular audits and compliance with the latest requirements and regulations. The office staff comprises four dedicated personnel, with a Transport Incharge managing all transport-related issues.

This comprehensive report highlights the school's commitment to providing a well-rounded education, modern facilities, and a supportive environment, ensuring the holistic development of its students.

School Management Committee

The School Management Committee is established per CBSE guidelines, ensuring robust governance of the Vidyalaya. The school's management is exceptionally supportive, providing essential funding and counsel for seamless operation. Regular meetings of the SMC foster a consultative decision-making process. Parent-Teacher Association

Evaluation System

In accordance with the principles of the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and CBSE guidelines**, the Vidyalaya follows a comprehensive, continuous, and competency-based assessment system aimed at nurturing holistic development and reducing academic stress.

For **Classes I and II**, the focus is on informal, activity-based assessment methods. Learning is evaluated through observation, oral responses, hands-on activities, and developmentally appropriate tools, integrated seamlessly into everyday classroom interactions. This approach ensures a stress-free and joyful learning experience, supporting the natural pace and individuality of each child.

For **Classes III to VIII**, a balanced blend of formative and summative assessments is followed. These include periodic pen-and-paper tests, oral quizzes, open book tests, project-based learning, subject enrichment activities, and art-integrated learning, ensuring the development of conceptual understanding, creativity, and critical thinking. Additionally, two term-end assessments are conducted annually to evaluate overall academic progress.

For **Classes IX and X**, the school adheres to the CBSE-prescribed examination pattern, incorporating internal assessments, periodic tests, practical work, and subject-specific projects to prepare students for board examinations.

The Examination Department maintains detailed academic records and ensures regular communication with parents through scheduled reporting and feedback, thereby reinforcing the home-school partnership in the learning process.

Embracing the National Education Policy 2020

Bhavan Vidyalaya, New Chandigarh, wholeheartedly embraces the vision and principles of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, fostering a well-rounded, joyful, and experiential learning environment. The curriculum is thoughtfully integrated with performing arts, visual arts, sports, and craft, extending even into core subjects such as English, Hindi, Science, Social Studies, and Mathematics. These activities not only make early learning enjoyable but also nurture imagination, language development, and problem-solving skills in young learners.

Through these initiatives, Bhavan Vidyalaya continues to evolve as a progressive learning space where every child’s potential is nurtured in a supportive, inclusive, and future-ready environment.

Sports and Physical Education

Bhavan Vidyalaya New Chandigarh offers excellent physical education and sports facilities to ensure ongoing student engagement. Activities include table tennis, chess, yoga, gymnastics, taekwondo, general fitness exercises, skating, and badminton. EMPOWERING MINDS: WORKSHOPS FOR STUDENTS

Throughout the academic year, the school conducted a series of enriching workshops designed to enhance students' skills, broaden their horizons, and inspire creativity. These sessions covered diverse topics, including drama, animal compassion, mental ability, stress management, first aid, and menstruation education.

a) Soliloquy Workshop
