5 students qualify for prestigious scholarship



5 students from the Sciences stream of Bhavan Vidyalaya, Chandigarh have done the Tricity proud by qualifying for the prestigious Kishor Vaigyanik Protsahan Yojana (KVPY) Scholarship 2020. Continuing the legacy of Bhavan Chandigarh in the competitive tests, Guramrit Singh of class XII secured the 22nd rank, while Pushpraj Poonia of the same grade secured the 72nd rank.
